



Shale Gas and Shale Oil vs Conventional HC








Shale Gas/ Shale Oil Basins Europe

Potential Shale Basins in Europe


















Estimated Shale Gas Resources Europe

No production experiences, limited exploration


Large uncertainties

EU still a long way from US success story








Typical risk and environmental issues considered in shale gas and shale oil development

EU Unconventional Oil and Gas Assessment (EUOGA)

- New project starting to "Fill the Data Gaps"
- EGS collaboration with JRC (Joint Research Council of EU)
- 2015-2016 (18 Months)
- Budget €700K
- Will provide comprehensive overview of current knowledge on Shale Gas potential areas in EU/EGS member countries
- Database created for further collaboration and research
- Led by GEUS (DK) & TNO (NL)
- But lots more to do!
