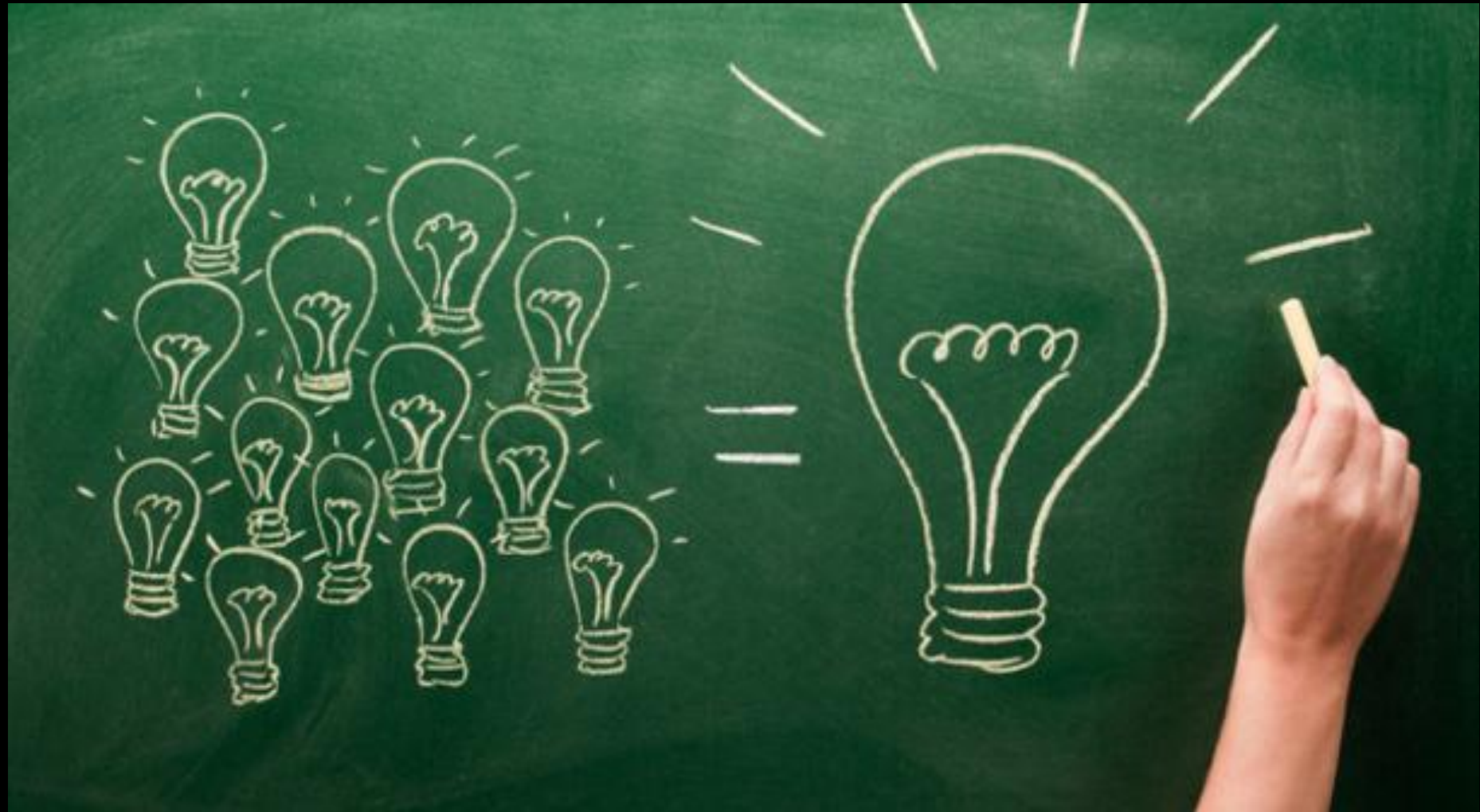

INVESTING IN PREVENTION & EARLY INTERVENTION: RECOMMENDATIONS

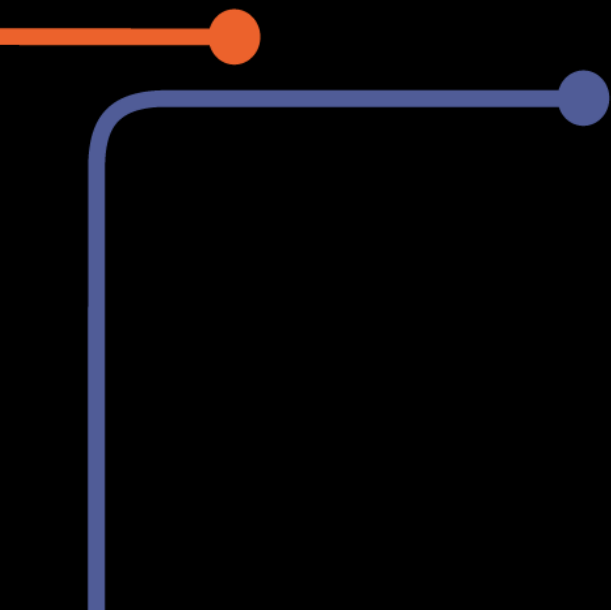
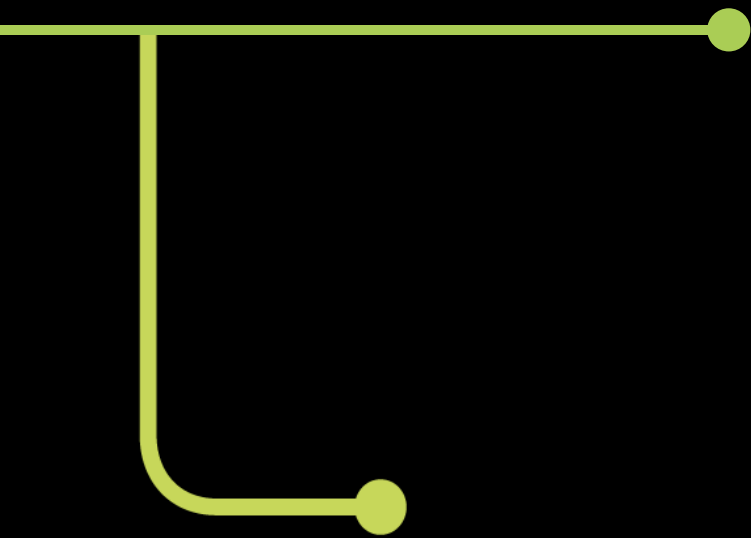
Smart health expenditure can be an investment rather than a cost

FOSTERING EMPOWERED AND RESPONSIBLE CITIZENS: RECOMMENDATIONS

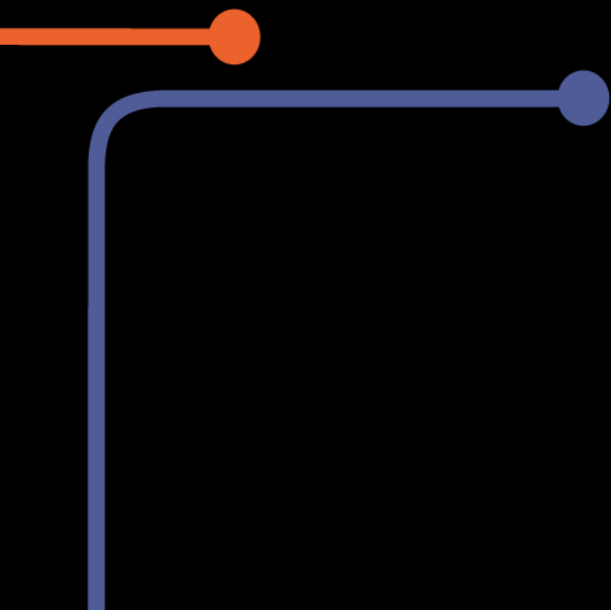
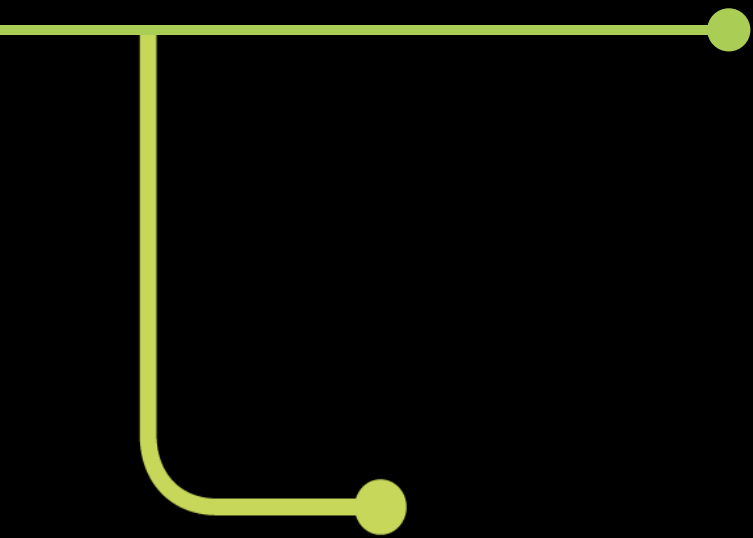
Empowered and responsible citizens are the main PLAYERS contributing to healthcare sustainability
